## Weekend Closure of South Capitol Street SE/SW November 8 – 11

(Washington, DC) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close all lanes on South Capitol Street SE/SW between Malcolm X Avenue and Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue beginning Friday, November 8 at 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. on Monday, November 11, 2019, weather permitting.

These lanes closures are necessary to complete paving operations related to the Rehabilitation of the Anacostia Freeway Bridges over South Capitol Street.

DDOT will provide variable message boards to alert the traveling public to these closures. Detour signs will also be prevalent along the closure route to guide motorists safely around each closure. DDOT encourages all motorists to stay alert while traveling through this busy corridor.
